Students are still financially responsible for the course(s). This completed form must be submitted to the Registrar's Office for processing by the appropriate deadline posted in the academic calendar on the University website at www.eastern.edu/registrar.

Attention Financial Aid Recipients: Eligibility for renewal of financial aid is based upon satisfactory academic progress at the end of the current year. Undergraduate students anticipating grants, student loans, or College Work Study for the next academic year must earn at least 24 credits in the current year. Students in the third or fourth years of aid must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0. Similar requirements apply to graduate students.
